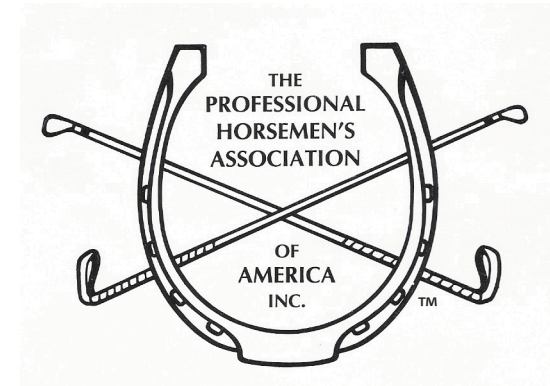

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of F-W PHA (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable -casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee.

Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.

The Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a Mandatory Line which will be indicated on course diagrams and posted at least one hour before the class is to begin.

Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA and/or NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA/NEHC rules. To show in CHJA/NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members of the respective organization. In order to compete for annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA/NEHC and the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA/NEHC. A copy of the CHJA and NEHC Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net and www.nehc.info

Rules and Regulations

1. Unless otherwise specified, all Hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness.
2. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horseshow management. The F-W PHA, Coker Farms and management will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, trainer & attendant holds the competition and management, officials, members, and employees harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals, or property at the show.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes if, in its opinion, the entries so warrant, while maintaining minimum USEF requirements to fill a class.
4. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a mandatory line. The same will be indicated on course diagrams & a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.
5. Each entry will be charged an office fee of \$30.
6. Jumper times calculated at 360 yd/min. For other than first place, time taken to complete the first round will decide between horses with equal faults. Jump orders will be established at the in-gate.
7. Exhibitors must possess current memberships for all organizations & classes which require the same. Fines levied against the horse show for invalid memberships will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
8. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license, which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will not be permitted to operate motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motor vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. *The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of the rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.* Penalties may include exclusion of child, parent(s), legal guardian(s) and/or trainer (competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed again above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
9. Appointments for measurements must be made 48 hours prior to the show with the on-call vet.
10. Any returned checks or unpaid billed entries will be charged an additional fee of \$100.
11. All dogs must be leashed & under control at all times. \$100 fine for loose dogs.
12. All classes, specifications & membership applications are available at the secretary's desk.
13. No stabling available.
14. The following division will receive CHJA points: CHJA Medal classes.
15. ***Approved protective headgear must be worn by anyone on a horse while on the facility.***
16. ***All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for Safe Sport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "**Agreement**"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("**Risks**").
